

Terms & Conditions: AGORED/OPEN 2025

We ask that all artists thoroughly read the terms and conditions prior to submitting your application.

The exhibition in Galeri's Art Space will take place between **22/11/25 – 31/01/26** and it is essential that your work is available for this period.

There is no age or geographical restriction for artists to apply. We encourage artists working in any medium (film, photography, portraits, craft, glass, sculpture etc) to present their work to be considered.

How to enter:

Application this year is online only. We kindly ask artists to upload:

1. No more than 5 digitised images (JPEG) 300dpi or film/video works (youtube/vimeo links), no more than 3 minutes each as well as dimensions and a price list
2. Artist's statement (no more than 200 words about yourself and your work)
3. Admission fee (non-refundable) £10 to be paid

Notification of outcome:

We will e-mail all artists with a notification of the outcome by **03/10/25**

Delivery & collection of work(s)

Artists must deliver the work as arranged with the Visual Arts Officer between **12/11/25 – 15/11/25**. The exhibition must be prepared and ready for opening as discussed/arranged with the Visual Arts Officer. The artist must arrange the collection of the work in accordance with the pre-arranged date as stated in the contract.

Transport of work to/from Galeri:

It is the responsibility of the artist to arrange transport of the work(s) to and from Galeri.

Installing the work:

Galeri's Visual Arts Officer and freelance team will hang and arrange all works within the space.

Insurance:

We strongly suggest that artists insure their work in transit to and from Galeri. Galeri's insurance policy will cover the work during the exhibition.

Commision on sales:

Galeri's commission on any sales will be 30% + VAT (please keep this in mind when pricing your work). The artist will keep the remainder of the sale price.

Presentation of the work:

All artworks should be presented in a professional manner. Poor presentation can affect the quality of the final work. For presentation and framing guidelines, please contact the Visual Arts Officer.
